
El Coqui Print & Play Set

Print, cut, and laminate each piece. Play some coqui sounds (YouTube has many). Arrange leaves onto the playing space to create a rainforest.

As you sing the folk song, have one friend close their eyes as everyone else hides the coqui under one of the leaves. After the song is over, the friend opens their eyes and lifts leaves off the playing space, trying to take off as many leaves as they can before finding the coqui. When the friend gets to the leaf with the coqui underneath, all friends start making calm coqui noises, to let the friend know they've found the coqui. The turn is over once the friend finds the leaf with the frog. Place all leaves back on the playing space, and the game begins again with a new friend.

It's also fun to just place the leaves out and encourage imaginary play, with the coqui jumping back and forth from leaf to leaf, making their special noise.
