Friends each decide if they are a bird or flower, and "act" accordingly. (Silent pantomiming, actions should not get in the way of the music or clear singing!) For example, a bird might flap its wings and a flower may hold their hands by their face like petals. Birds may "fly" around the room walking to the steady beat, while flowers might choose to form a garden or meadow and "sway in the wind" to the steady beat. Be imaginative and playful! On the word "disappear", all friends find a hiding place around the room. Sing the second verse in your hiding spot until the word "reappear", when all friends come out to celebrate spring again as birds and flowers.

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
