


Hop Old Squirrel

Game

All friends choose one person to be the squirrel. Sing the first verse as the squirrel hops around and acts like a squirrel. Then, everyone but the squirrel closes their eyes while the squirrel chooses a hiding spot as everyone sings the hiding verse. Then friends open their eyes and look around for the squirrel during the hunting verse. If they find the squirrel, sing the run verse and a chase ensues! If not, the squirrel peeps out during the peeping verse and then the chase ensues!
