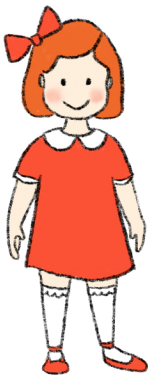


Ma-ry wore her red dress, red dress, red dress,
