

My Nice Red Rosy Apple

Apple Cards

Ways to play:

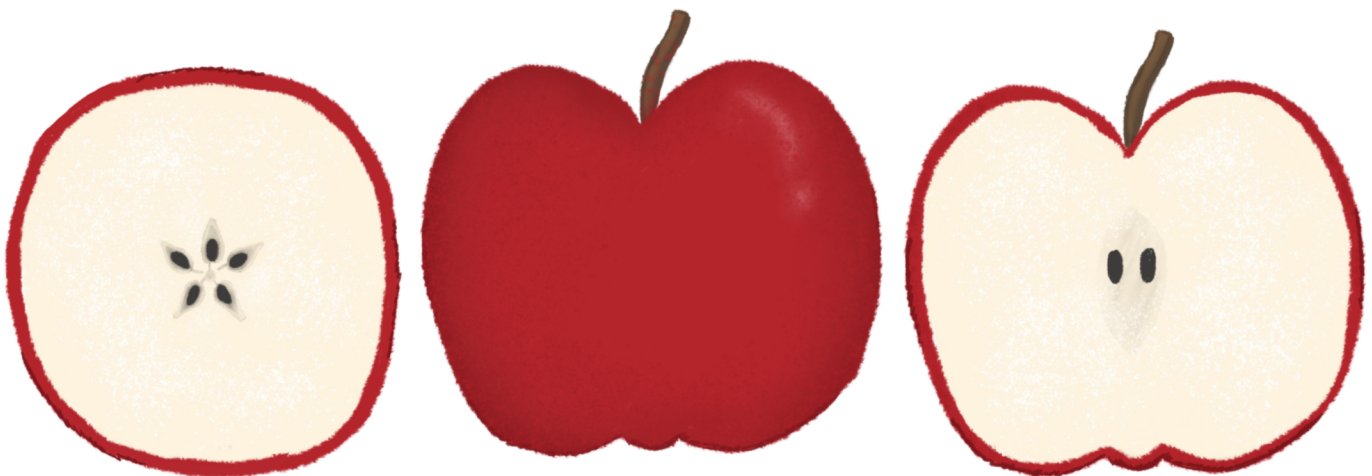
Print two copies onto cardstock so that the cards aren't see-through. Cut, then laminate if desired.

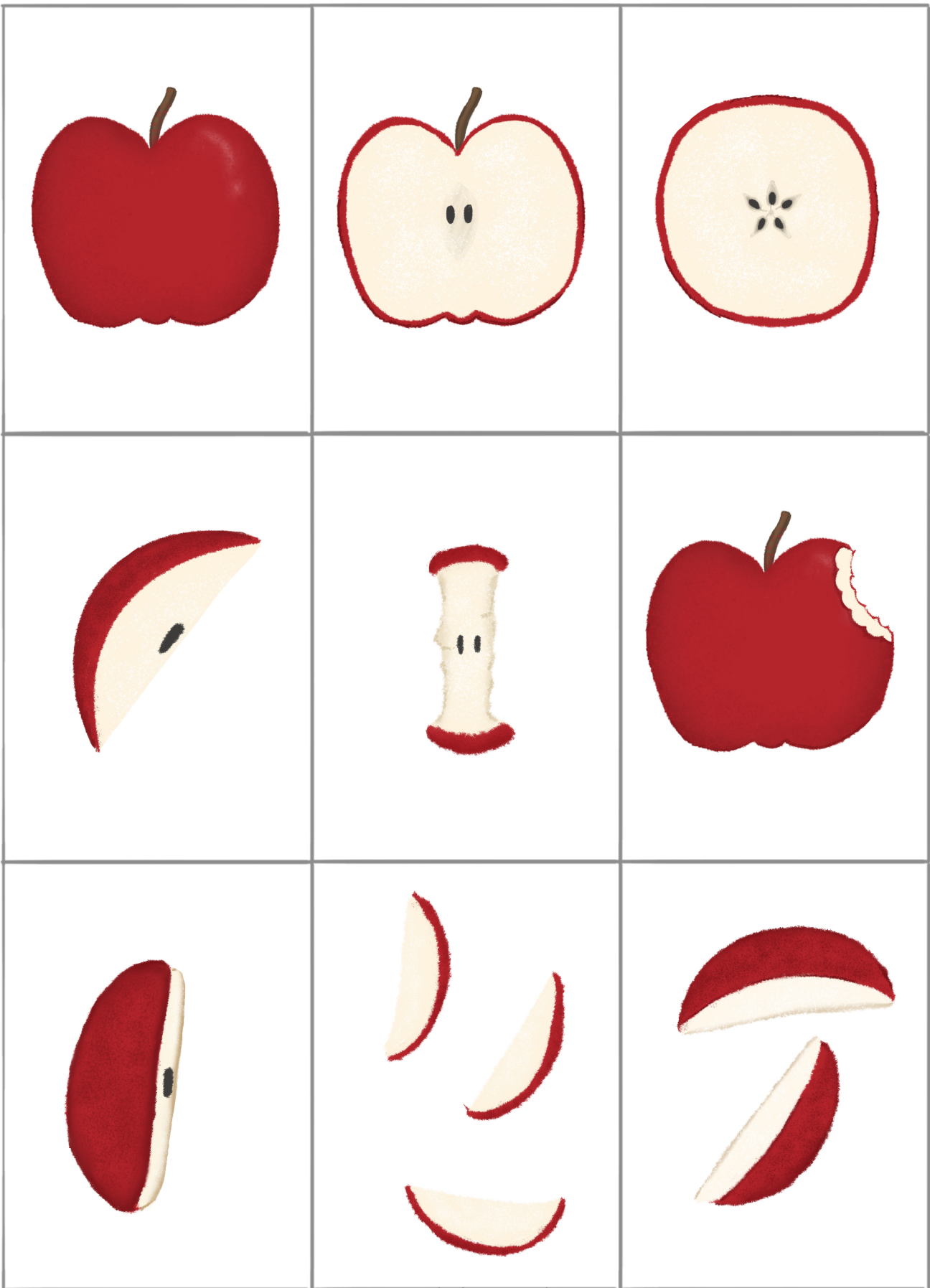
Memory: Mix up the cards and arrange face down in a grid. Players take turns trying to find matches. If they get a match, they get an extra turn. The Apple Card showing the "star" of the apple is worth double. The players with the most matches at the end of the game wins. Sing the folk song at the end to celebrate.

Old Maid: remove one of the apple core cards so only one remains in the deck. Players are dealt the rest of the cards. Sing the song as you shuffle and deal out the cards. Players take turns picking a card (without looking) from the other players. if they make a match. They lay that down. Play continues until one player is left with the apple core.

Extension:

Apple Printing: An adult cuts an apple in half to show the star, apply paint to the flat side and stamp onto sturdy paper as you sing.
